Introduction lecture

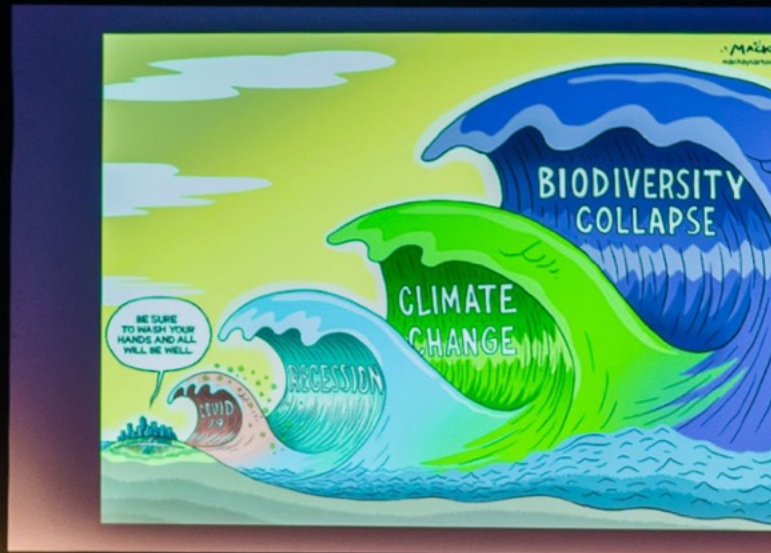
Meet the Next Nature Museum during an inspiring introduction lecture.

The Next Nature philosophy offers an innovative view of the relationship between nature and technology, and helps us to think more deeply about possible technologies and visions of the future.

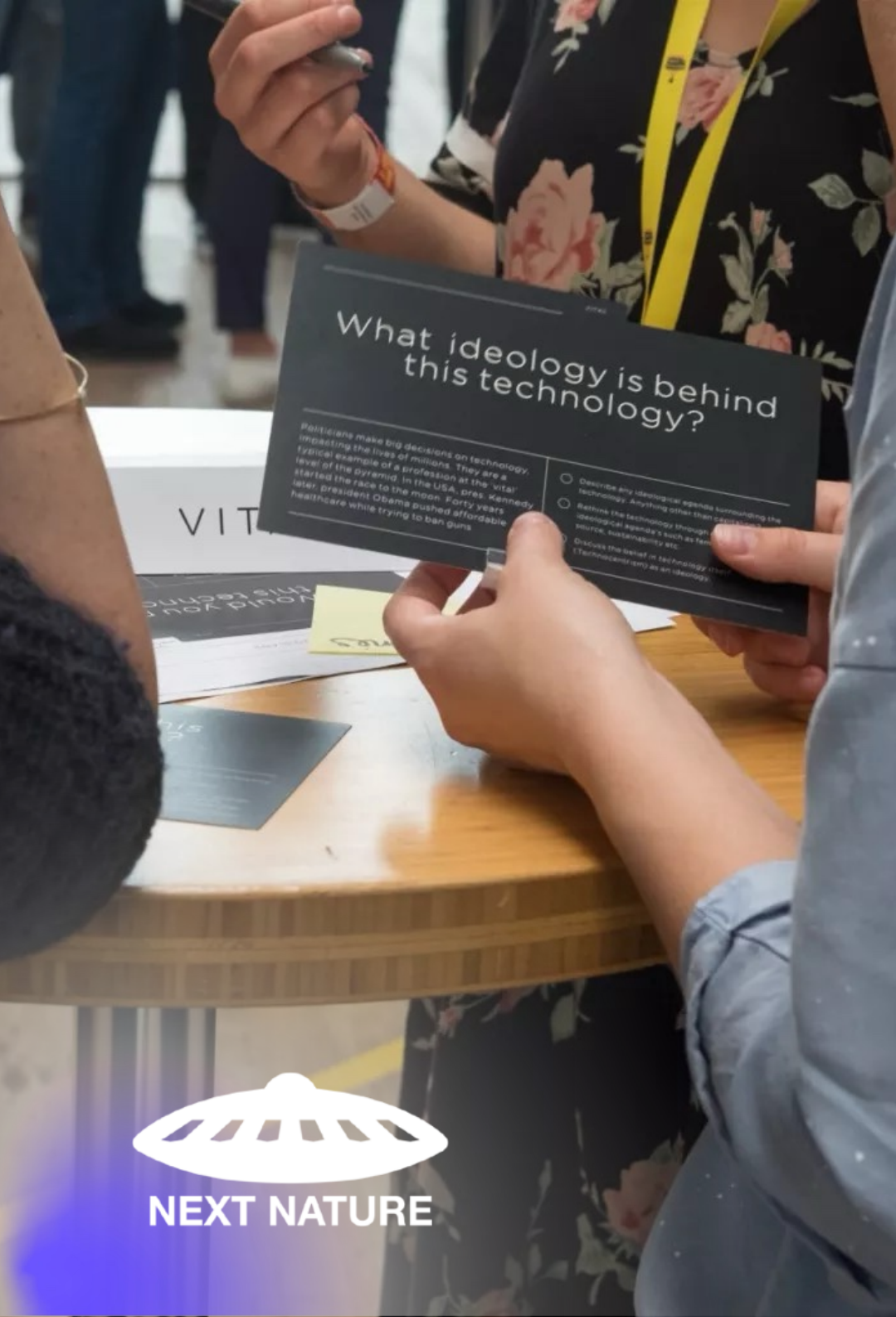
To make this visible, we work, among other things, with exhibitions that can be visited in the Next Nature Museum.
